

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING WOODMAR SQUARE PHASE II OF 309 LEGAL ARTS CENTRE, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO, 44503 TO PROCEED UNDER SECTION 307.73 R.C. OF OHIO, WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN 18" SANITARY SEWER IN WESTERN RESERVE ROAD BEGINNING AT AN EXISTING SANITARY MANHOLE IN WESTERN RESERVE ROAD, LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 60 FEET EAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF GLENWOOD AVENUE, THENCE EASTERLY IN WESTERN RESERVE ROAD APPROXIMATELY 1,415 FEET TO A POINT LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 320 FEET WEST OF THE CENTERLINE OF S.R. NO. 7 (MARKET STREET) IN BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a letter of application to proceed under Section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio with the installation of a sanitary sewer at the above described location has been filed with this Board, and

WHEREAS, any non-participants along the line of the installation shall be required to pay a pro-rata share of the construction costs, based on the front footage, and

WHEREAS, certified copies of the completed work shall be filed at the office of the County Sanitary Engineer, 761 Industrial Road, Youngstown, Ohio, so that a tapping charge to non-participants may be determined, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio, effective August 23, 1972, a one dollar Auditors Filing Fee received of said Woodmar Square Phase II accompanies this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mahoning County, State of Ohio, that Woodmar Square Phase II of 309 Legal Arts Centre, Youngstown, Ohio, 44503 be, and they are hereby authorized to proceed under Section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio, with the construction of an 18" sanitary sewer in Western Reserve Road beginning at an existing sanitary manhole in Western Reserve Road located approximately 60 feet east of the centerline of Glenwood Avenue, thence easterly in Western Reserve Road approximately 1,415 feet to a point located approximately 320 feet west of the centerline of S.R. 7 in Boardman Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, in accordance with the regulations governing sewer line construction in Mahoning County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any monies collected from non-participants shall be forwarded to the applicant.

It was moved by Mr. Barrett seconded by Mr. Palermo that the foregoing resolution be approved and passed this 29 day of June, 1978.
