AUTHORIZING J & M INVESTMENTS OF 971 NEW ROAD, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO 44515 OHIO TO PROCEED UNDER OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 307.73 WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF 1,415' OF 8" SANITARY SEWER AND 1,200' OF 8" WATER LINE IN NEW ROAD AND MARY PLACE, CHAPEL VALLEY DEVELOPMENT, AUSTINTOWN TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, a letter of application to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 with construction of sanitary sewer and water line in Austintown Township has been received by this Board, and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary Engineer has reviewed the proposed routes of the sanitary sewer and water line and has recommended the Board approve the request to construct the sanitary sewer and water line, and

WHEREAS, any non-participants, specifically lot(s) on the north side of New Road and designated lots in the Chapel Valley Development along the route of the sanitary sewer and water line benefitting from the construction shall be required to pay a pro-rata share of the project costs calculated on the front footage, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 dated March 15, 1989, a one dollar (\$1.00) Auditor's Filing Fee has been submitted by J & M Investments and accompanies this resolution.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Mahoning County, State of Ohio, that J & M Investments, 6971 New Road, Youngstown, Ohio 44515, be and they are hereby authorized to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 with the construction of approximately 1,415' of 8" sanitary sewer and 1,200' of 8" water line in New Road and Mary Place, Chapel Valley Development, Austintown Township in accordance with provisions regulating the construction of sanitary sewers and water lines in Mahoning County.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any monies collected from non-participants shall be forwarded to J & M Investments.
