AUTHORIZING DONALD R. BOOTH, THE DON BOOTH COMPANY,
245 SOUTH SALEM-WARREN ROAD, NORTH JACKSON, OHIO 44451
TO CONSTRUCT A WATER LINE IN NORTH JACKSON TOWNSHIP
OHIO IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 307.73.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners received a recommendation from the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer to extend the water line in SR 45 in North Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the recommendation of the Sanitary Engineer and hereby approves the construction of a water line in SR 45, beginning approximately 400' south of Mahoning Avenue Extension and extend approximately 1,100 feet and service the east and west sides of SR 45; and

WHEREAS, benefitting properties that are located on the east and west side of SR 45 and listed on file at the Sanitary Engineering Department and Auditors Office are the benefitting non participating properties for the purpose of cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 dated March 15, 1989, a one dollar (\$1.00) Auditors Filing Fee has been submitted by Mr. Donald R. Booth, The Don Booth Company of North Jackson, Ohio and accompanies this resolution.

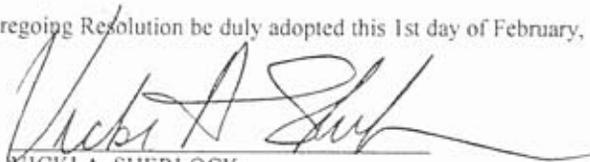
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners, State of Ohio, that on the recommendation of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer, that Mr. Donald R. Booth, is hereby authorized under Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 to construct a water line in North Jackson Township, Mahoning County, Ohio,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the non-participating benefitting properties as designated on plans in the office of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer shall reimburse the Mr. Don R. Booth as a pro-rata share of the construction cost based on cost per front foot.

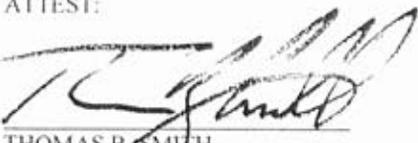
It was moved by Mrs. Sherlock, and seconded by Mr. Reese, that the foregoing Resolution be approved this 1st day of February, 2001.
