

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING MR. DENNIS ORR, 5599 MUIRFIELD DRIVE, CANFIELD, OHIO 44406  
TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER LINE IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP  
OHIO IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 307.73.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners received a recommendation from the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer to extend a sanitary sewer approximately 1,000 feet along the rear properties of parcels on the east side of SR 45 and adjacent to the Jackson Meadows Development, Jackson Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the recommendation of the Sanitary Engineer and hereby approves the construction of the sanitary sewer line beginning at an existing manhole located on Fawn Meadow St. approximately 225' north of Jackson Meadow Avenue then extending 243' west along the north property line of the Jackson Twp. Fire Station to a manhole and then extending approximately 985' north in an easement along the rear property lines of residents of SR 45(Salem-Warren Road); and

WHEREAS, benefitting properties on the east side of SR 45(Salem -Warren Road) are non participating for purpose of cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 dated March 15, 1989, a one dollar (\$1.00) Auditors Filing Fee has been submitted by Mr. Dennis Orr of Canfield, Ohio and accompanies this resolution.

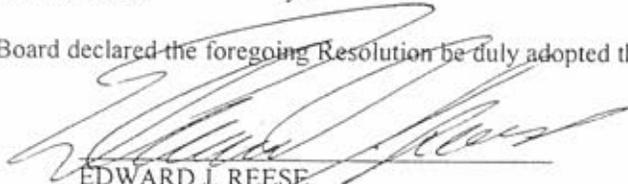
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners, State of Ohio, that on the recommendation of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer, that Mr. Dennis Orr, 5599 Muirfield Drive, Canfield, Ohio, is hereby authorized under Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 to construct a sanitary sewer line in Jackson Township, Mahoning County, Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the non-participating benefitting properties as designated on plans in the office of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer shall reimburse Mr. Dennis Orr a pro-rata share of the construction cost based on cost per front foot.

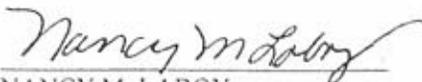
It was moved by Mr. Ludt, and seconded by Mrs. Sherlock, that the foregoing Resolution be approved this 16th day of May, 2002.
