

RESOLUTION  
RES 05-09-008

AUTHORIZING MR. JOHN J. MONROE, 6899 CALLA ROAD, CANFIELD, OHIO 44406  
TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER IN AUSTINTOWN TOWNSHIP AND  
LIMITED AREAS IN TRUMBULL COUNTY OHIO  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 307.73.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners received a recommendation from the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer for the proposed project beginning at the intersection of Ohltown Road and Austintown Warren Road in Trumbull County; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the recommendation of the Sanitary Engineer and hereby approves the construction of the sanitary sewer beginning at an existing manhole located in an easement of the Mahoning Valley Sanitary District, southwest of the intersection of Ohltown Road and Austintown Warren Road in Trumbull County and extending south into Mahoning County along the easterly right-of-way of Ohltown Road approximately 2,050 feet; and

WHEREAS, properties on the east and west side of Ohltown Road and listed on file at the Sanitary Engineering Department and Auditors Office are the benefitting non participating properties for the purpose of cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 dated March 15, 1989, a one dollar (\$1.00) Auditors Filing Fee has been submitted by Mr. John J. Monroe of Canfield Ohio and accompanies this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners, State of Ohio, that on the recommendation of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer, that John J. Monroe is hereby authorized under Ohio Revised Code Section 307.73 to construct a sanitary sewer in Austintown Township, Mahoning County and limited areas in Trumbull County, Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the non-participating benefitting properties as designated on plans in the office of the Mahoning County Sanitary Engineer shall reimburse the Mr. John J. Monroe a pro-rata share of the construction cost based on cost per front foot.

It was moved by Mr. McNally, and seconded by Mr. Ludt, that the foregoing Resolution be approved this 8th day of September, 2005.
