RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING MR. WILLIAM J. GLEASON, 4627 SHERIDAN ROAD, PERMISSION UNDER SECTION 307.75 R. C., TO CONSTRUCT AN EIGHT (8) INCH WATER LINE IN LEMOYNE AVENUE, PINE HOLLOW SEWER DISTRICT NUMBER TWELVE # (12), BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, application for the construction of an eight (8) inch water line under Section 307.73 R. C., State of Ohio, has been filed with the MAHONING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS on October 20, 1958; and

WHEREAS, a list of names of lot owners not participating in the original cost is included with the application; and

WHEREAS, a prorated share of the cost of the improvement shall be collected and returned to Mr. William J. Gleason in the event any non-participant applies for a water tap. The prorated share shall be based on the foot frontage and shall not exceed the amount chargeable if such non-participant had participated in this improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that Mr. William J. Gleason be authorized to proceed with the installation of an eight (8) inch water line from a northerly line of Sub Lot No. 27, Elmwood Place Plat as recorded in Volume 13, page 77 of Mahoning County Records of Plats,

THENCE, extending in a southerly direction on Lemoyne Avenue, a distance of about seven hundred (700) feet to a point in the intersection of Lemoyne Avenue and Basil Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Board shall collect and return to Mr. William J. Gleason a prorated share of the costs of the improvement to be determined when Mr. William J. Gleason submit final costs of the completed improvement to the County Sanitary Engineer located at 940 Bears Den Road, Youngstown 11, Ohio.

TO CONSTRUCT A WATER LINE IN LEMOYNE AVENUE, PINE HOLLOW SEWER DISTRICT NO. TWELVE # (12), BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.
