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RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING MR. HARRY LEV AND MR. WILLIAM GLEASON, 41 LINDEN AVENUE, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO, PERMISSION UNDER SECTION 307.73 R. C. TO CONSTRUCT SANITARY SEWERS AND LATERALS IN SHERIDAN ROAD, WOODLAWN AVENUE AND OLES AVENUE, POLAND SEWER DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR #4, BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, application for the construction of the Sanitary Sewer line and laterals under Section 307.73 R. C., State of Ohio, has been filed with the Mahoning County Commissioners on August 27, 1958; and

WHEREAS, a list of names of lot owners not participating in the original cost is included with the application; and

WHEREAS, a pro-rated share of the cost of the improvement shall be collected and returned to Mr. Harry Lev and Mr. William Gleason in the event any non-participant applies for a sewer tap. The pro-rated share shall be based on the foot frontage and shall not exceed the amount chargeable if such non-participant had participated in this improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that Mr. Harry Lev and Mr. William Gleason be authorized to proceed with the installation of a Sanitary Sewer and laterals on Sheridan Road from the end of the existing Sanitary Sewer in front of lot # 57, Poland Crest Plat;

THENCE, south, a distance of five hundred and sixty-four feet (564') on Woodlawn Avenue from Sheridan Road west, a distance of one thousand two hundred and twenty feet (1,220) on Oles Avenue from Sheridan Road west, a distance of one thousand one hundred and fifty feet (1,150) to lots # 99 and # 128.

PERMISSION TO CONSTRUCT SANITARY

and return to Mr. Harry Lev and Mr. William Gleason a pro-rated
share of the costs of the improvement to be determined when Mr.
Harry Lev and Mr. William Gleason submit final costs of the
completed improvement to the County Sanitary Engineer located
at 940 Bears Den Road, Youngstown 11, Ohio.
