

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING A.R. JOHNSON, STEVE CHELEKIS AND CHRIS CHENGELIS TO PROCEED UNDER SECTION 307.03 R.C. TO CONSTRUCT WATER LINES IN MILL CREEK BOULEVARD AND PLYMOUTH DRIVE IN MILL CREEK SEWER DISTRICT NO. 16, BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a letter and accompanying plan has been submitted to the Mahoning County Commissioners from the above named persons seeking permission to construct water lines under section 307.73 R.C., and,

WHEREAS, a complete list of owners and their lot numbers are included in the letter; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of construction for the water lines is shown on the accompanying plan in the amount of (7250.00); and,

WHEREAS, a final cost will be submitted to the County Sanitary Engineer, 940 Bears Den Road when the work is completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that A.R. Johnson, Steve Chelekis and Chris Chengelis be permitted to proceed under section 307.73 R.C., to construct water lines in Mill Creek Boulevard and Plymouth Drive in Mill Creek Sewer District No. 16, Boardman Township, Mahoning County, Ohio.

BE, IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a tapping charge be set against all non-participating lots and when final construction costs are submitted and at the time a permit is requested the non-participating applicant shall pay a front footage tapping charge to the Sanitary Engineering Department 940 Bears Den Road; and,

BE, IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said monies collected shall be returned to A.R. Johnson, Steve Chelekis and Chris Chengelis.
