

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THOMAS AND PATRICIA REESE, OWNERS OF LOT NO. 52, IN BRANDON AVENUE, BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, PERMISSION TO PROCEED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 307.73 R.C., AND CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER IN BRANDON AVENUE FROM AN EXISTING MANHOLE ON THE EASTERLY SIDE OF SHERIDAN ROAD TO AND INCLUDING LOT NO. 52, SITUATED IN THE ELMWOOD PLACE PLAT AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 15, PAGE 40, MAHONING COUNTY RECORD OF PLATS.

WHEREAS, an application to proceed with the installation of said sanitary sewer has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners on June 3, 1963, and

WHEREAS, said application sets forth the total cost of the construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that Thomas and Patricia Reese of 1803 Brandon Avenue be authorized to proceed with the construction of the above described sanitary sewer in said street, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event any non-participant applies for a sewer permit, a pro-rated share of the cost based on the foot frontage shall be collected by the Sanitary Engineering Department, 940 Bears Den Road, Youngstown, Ohio, and said monies collected shall be returned to the applicants.

It was moved by Mr. PALERMO, seconded by Mr. GILRONAN that the foregoing resolution be approved and passed this 1st day of JULY, 1963.
