

R E S O L U T I O N

AUTHORIZING GEORGE BECKER TO PROCEED UNDER SECTION 307.73 R.C. OF OHIO WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER AND WATER LINE IN LOCKWOOD BLVD. FROM THE EXISTING LINE IN FRONT OF LOT NO. 69 OF THE TRUESDALE PLAT NO. 2 THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 538 FEET, PARK SEWER DISTRICT NO. 29, BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a letter of application dated November 12, 1964 to proceed under Section 307.73 R. C. has heretofore been filed with the Board and,

WHEREAS, the application contains the names and frontages of non-participating land owners to be charged tapping fees at the time a water and sewer connection is applied for and,

WHEREAS, such monies collected in the form of tapping charges shall be returned to said applicants.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that George Becker of 930 Poland Ave., Youngstown, Ohio is authorized to proceed, under Section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio, with the construction of a sanitary sewer and water line in Lockwood Blvd. from the existing line in front of Lot No. 69 of the Truesdale Plat No. 2 thence southwesterly a distance of 538 feet in Park Sewer District No. 29, Boardman Township, Mahoning County, Ohio.

I, George Becker, owner of Lots #64, 65, and 66 in Truesdale Plat #2 located on the southeasterly side of Lockwood Blvd., Boardman Township, Ohio, respectfully petition the County Commissioners of Mahoning County for permission to construct and install a 8" Sanitary sewer and a 6" Water line from a point in front of Lot #69 of said plat which is the terminal of a present sewer and water line, to a point southwesterly in Lockwood Blvd. ending in front of subplot #64 of Truesdale Plat #2 as shown by the Recorded plat in Volume 29 of Maps Page 21 of Mahoning County Records.

Your petitioner requests that said permission be granted to install said Sanitary Sewer and Water line under the supervision of your office and the Water Department of the City of Youngstown as provided by Revised Code 307.73 of the State of Ohio.

Your petitioner represents that he has entered into a contract with Jim Andio & Sons for the construction of said sewer and water lines for the contract price of \$3,419.00 plus County Inspectors charges. Said contract provided in substances as follows:
