

R E S O L U T I O N

AUTHORIZING BOSTON CONSTRUCTION CO.,  
STAMBAUGH BUILDING, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO  
TO PROCEED UNDER SECTION 307.73 R.C.  
WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A SANITARY  
SEWER IN MATHEWS ROAD, POLAND SEWER  
NO. 4, POLAND TOWNSHIP, MAHONING  
COUNTY, OHIO

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WHEREAS, a letter of application, dated October 12, 1966,  
to proceed under section 307.73 with the installation of a  
sanitary sewer in Mathews Road from an existing manhole located  
on the south side of Mathews Road at the rear line of lots, said  
point located approximately 100' west of Lightner Place, thence  
northerly to a point located 5' north of the south property line  
of Mathews Road, thence westerly in Mathews Road an approximate  
distance of 850', is on file in the County Commissioners's Office  
and,

WHEREAS, in the event any non-participant along the route  
of the extension makes application for a sewer permit, a tapping  
charge will be collected based on the foot frontage and to be  
determined after final costs of the completed work are submitted  
to the Sanitary Engineer's Office at 940 Bears Den Road, Young-  
stown, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County  
Commissioners that the Boston Construction Co. be and are hereby  
authorized to proceed under section 307.73 R.C. with the install-  
ation of a Sanitary Sewer in Poland Sewer District No. 4, Poland  
Township, Mahoning County, Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a pro-rated share of the costs  
will be returned to the Boston Construction Co., Stambaugh  
Building, Youngstown, Ohio at the time any non-participant applies  
for a Sanitary Sewer Permit.

It was moved by Mr. BARRETT, seconded by Mr. BINDAS
