RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING FRANK NICHOLSON OF 806 YOUNGSTOWN
POLAND ROAD TO PROCEED UNDER SECTION 307.73 R.C.
WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN
BRANDON AVENUE, IN BOARDMAN SEWER DISTRICT NO.
1, BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a letter of application, dated March 23, 1961
to proceed under section 307.73 R.C. with the installation of a sanitary
sewer in Brandon Avenue beginning at an existing sanitary man-hole located
approximately 60 feet west of the Youngstown Poland Road, thence
on the west side of the Youngstown Poland Road northerly an approximate
distance of 275 feet, is on file in the County Commissioner's office and;

WHEREAS, in the event any non-participant along the route
of the extension makes application for a sewer permit, a tapping charge
will be collected based on the foot frontage and to be determined after
final costs of the completed work are submitted to the Sanitary Engineer's
office at 940 Bears Den Road, Youngstown, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County
Commissioner's that Mr. Frank Nicholson be and he is hereby authorized
to proceed under section 307.73 R.C. with the installation of a Sanitary
Sewer in Boardman Sewer District No. 1, Boardman Township, Mahoning
County, Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a pro-rated share of the
costs will be returned to Mr. Frank Nicholson of 806 Youngstown Poland
Road at the time any non-participant applies for a sanitary Sewer Permit.
