

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING ST. CATHERINE PARISH, BISHOP EMMET M. WALSH, OWNERS OF PROPERTY FRONTING ON JERSEY STREET AND GRANDVIEW BOULEVARD, BETWEEN LAKEWOOD AVENUE ON THE SOUTH, AND ROBINSON ROAD, ON THE NORTH, LAKE MILTON, OHIO. PERMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER AND A WATER LINE UNDER SECTION 307.73 R. C.

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WHEREAS, a letter of application to construct the above named Improvements under Section 307.73 R. C. was filed with the Board of County Commissioners on August 6, 1958; and

WHEREAS, a pro-rated share of the cost of the Improvement shall be collected and returned to the owners in the event any non-participant applies for a water tap. The pro-rated share shall be based on the foot frontage and shall not exceed the amount chargeable if such non-participant had participated in this Improvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that St. Catherine Parish, Bishop Emmet M. Walsh, owners of property fronting on Jersey Street and Grandview Boulevard, between Lakewood Avenue on the south, and Robinson Road, on the north, Lake Milton, Ohio, be authorized to proceed with the installation of a Sanitary Sewer and water line under Section 307.73 R. C.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Board shall collect and return to St. Catherine Parish, Bishop Emmet M. Walsh, owners of property, a pro-rated share of the cost of the Improvement to be determined when said St. Catherine Parish, Bishop Emmet M. Walsh, owners of property, submits final costs of the completed Improvement to the County Sanitary Engineer's Office located at 940 Bears Den Road, Youngstown 11, Ohio.

It was moved by Mr. Palermo, seconded by Mr. Carney that the foregoing Resolution be approved and passed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1958.
