AUTHORIZING STRATFORD ENTERPRISES, INC.
OF 5208 MAHONING AVENUE, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO
PERMISSION UNDER SECTION 307.73 R.C. OF
OHIO TO PROCEED WITH THE INSTALLATION OF
AN 8-INCH WATER LINE IN WEST BOULEVARD
RIGHT-OF-WAY A DISTANCE OF 1,680 FEET SOUTH
OF U.S. 224 IN BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING
COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a letter of application to proceed under Section 307.73 R.C. with the installation of an 8-inch water line in West Boulevard right-of-way a distance of 1,680 feet south of U.S. 224, dated November 8, 1972, has been filed with this Board, and

WHEREAS, any non-participants along the line of the installation shall be required to pay a pro-rated share of the construction costs, based on the front footage, and

WHEREAS, certified copies of the completed work shall be filed at the office of the County Sanitary Engineer, 863 Industrial Road, Youngstown, Ohio so that a tapping charge to non-participants may be determined, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amended Section 307.73 R.C., effective August 23, 1972, a one dollar Auditor's filing fee, received of said Stratford Enterprises, Inc., accompanies this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mahoning County, State of Ohio that Stratford Enterprises, Inc. be and they are hereby authorized to proceed with the installation of an 8-inch water line in West Boulevard right-of-way a distance of 1,680 feet south of U.S. 224 in compliance with the above named section and according to the rules and regulations governing water line construction in Mahoning County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any monies collected from the non-participants shall be forwarded to the applicant.
