

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING RHEA-JEAN HOLDING AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION PERMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER LINE IN RACCOON ROAD IN AUSTINTOWN SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 5, AUSTINTOWN TOWNSHIP, IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 307.73 R.C. OF OHIO.

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WHEREAS, application to construct a sanitary sewer under section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio was filed with the Board on February 14, 1966 and;

WHEREAS, the route of the proposed sewer is further described as follows:

Starting from the present end of a sanitary sewer now ending on Oakwood Avenue approximately twenty (20) feet east of Raccoon Road, along Raccoon Road between Oakwood Avenue and Idlewood Avenue, the sewer to be constructed from its present point on Oakwood, west to Raccoon and thence south to Idlewood Avenue, a distance of approximately six hundred feet.

WHEREAS, upon completion of the above described sewers the applicant shall file a certified copy of the actual cost of construction to the County Sanitary Engineer so that tapping charges based on the front foot can be placed against non-participating land. Said tapping charges collected shall be returned to Rhea-Jean Holding and Development Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that Rhea-Jean Holding and Development Corporation be permitted to construct a sanitary sewer line in Raccoon Road in Austintown Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, Austintown Township, in compliance with section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio.

It was moved by Mr. BINDAS seconded by Mr. BARRETT that the foregoing resolution be approved and passed this 21 day of FEBRUARY, 1966.
