

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA PERMISSION UNDER SECTION 307.73 R. C. OF OHIO TO PROCEED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ATTACHED PLANS, IN AUSTINTOWN TOWNSHIP, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, an application requesting permission to install the sanitary sewer has been hereto submitted and is on file in the Mahoning County Commissioners office, and;

WHEREAS, upon completion, the Union Oil Company of California must submit a certified copy of as-built costs so that a pro-rated share of the completed work may be computed and collected from non-participants located along the route of construction, and;

WHEREAS, such monies collected shall be returned to the applicants in a manner provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mahoning County, Ohio, that the Union Oil Company be and they are hereby authorized to proceed under Section 307.73 R.C. of Ohio with the construction of a sewer line in accordance with the attached plans in Mineral Ridge Sewer District No. 18, Austintown Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that tapping charges collected shall be deposited in the 307.73 private construction fund and the applicant shall be reimbursed a proportionate share of the cost as determined by the Sanitary Engineer.
